Social events are organised throughout the year. An annual dinner evening includes the Annual General Meeting. Social events provide the opportunity for informal interaction between members.

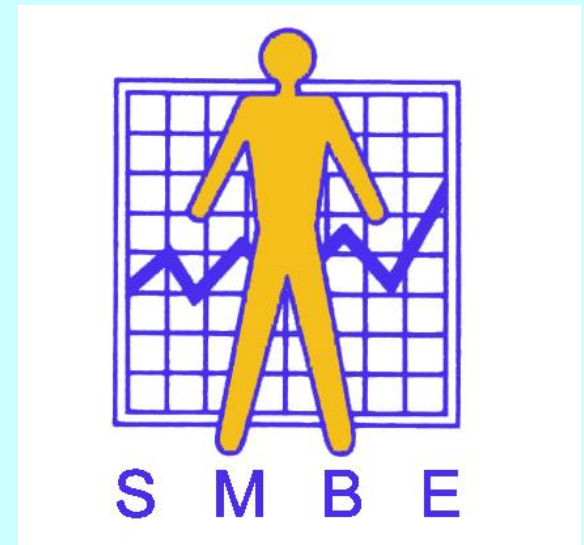
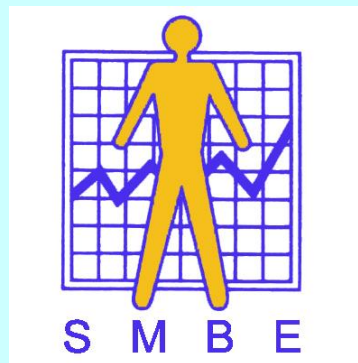

The State Societies, together with Engineers Australia Biomedical College and the Biomedical Engineering members of the Australasian College of Physical Scientists & Engineers in Medicine (ACPSEM), form the membership of the Australian Federation for Medical and Biological Engineering (AFMBE). Annual national conferences for Biomedical Engineers and Physical Scientists have been organised by Engineers Australia, the AFMBE and ACPSEM.

AFMBE is a member society of the International Federation of Medical and Biological Engineering (IFMBE) which convenes regular international conferences. The IFMBE also publishes the Journal for Medical and Biological Engineering and Computing: SMBE members are eligible for greatly reduced rates when subscribing to this Journal.
