About Port Macquarie and the Mid-North Coast

Port Macquarie is a town at the mouth of the Hastings River on the mid-north coast of New South Wales, Australia. The climate is mild with average temperatures ranging from 18 degrees C to 25 degrees C in the month of March. "Port" as the locals call it, is a family holiday destination for thousands of tourists in the summer but it also has plenty of venues for a lively night life.

It's known for its beaches, wildlife and penal colony past. St. Thomas' Anglican Church was built by convicts in the 19th century.

A coastal walk from the town centre to the 19th-century Tacking Point Lighthouse offers views over waters home to whales and dolphins. Billabong Zoo is known for its koala breeding centre.

Getting there...

Easily accessed by road, rail and air, it really is a beautiful place and certainly **the place to be** in March 2024.

Travelling by car:

- Drive from Sydney via the M1 and Pacific Hwy/A1 (387 km)
- Drive from Melbourne via the Hume Highway M31 to Sydney and then the M1/A1 (1253 km)
- Drive from Brisbane via the M1 and Pacific Hwy/A1 (544 km)

Travelling by plane: Fly from Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane, Adelaide or Perth to Port Macquarie Airport.

Travelling by bus: There are cheap bus options available. Premier and Greyhound services operating between Sydney and Brisbane stop in Port Macquarie.

Where can you stay?

The conference, welcome BBQ and dinner venues are in the heart of Port Macquarie where a wide range of accommodation types are to be found.
